## Where is Bridgetown?

Bridgetown is the capital of Barbados located on the island's southwest coast and less than 30 minutes from the airport.

## What is the campus like?

The campus is centrally located in the medical district. This allows local doctors, hospitals, and clinics to work collaboratively with our students.

Campus location allows students access to banks, grocery stores, restaurants, and other amenities within walking distance. For a quick get-away students can take a quick 10 minute walk to the beach.

### Student Support

Students are supported by an assigned faculty advisor, counselling services, academic and time management, and Academic Support Services in Student Training designed to help medical students who are experiencing academic difficulties.

11:1 student to faculty ratio ensures that students are able to get the assistance they need directly from professors.

Transportation program with a local vendor assists students, faculty and staff with safe and affordable transportation resources to navigate the island. The principal objective is to remove the individual need for a personal vehicle while students are living on the island.

# What could I study?

#### **Bachelors of Medical Sciences**

The 3-year program at AUIS provides students with a firm foundational knowledge of science and humanities required by professional schools while also offering opportunities to explore health fields. Years 1 and 2 of the degree program offer an accelerated pathway to Medical School through completion of all prerequisite coursework and the 90-credit hour US medical school application requirements within the first four semesters of study.

#### 4 Year MD

The Doctor of Medicine (MD) program at American University of Integrative Sciences is a 4 year program. The first two years of the four-year MD program concentrate on the traditional basic science disciplines on our campus in Barbados. The final two years focus on clinical sciences, with training at AUIS's affiliated hospitals and clinical centers in the United States, United Kingdom, and Canada.

#### 5 Year MD

The Pre-medical sciences component of the 5-year program offers an accelerated pathway from High School to Medical School through completion of all prerequisite coursework and the 90-credit hour US medical school application requirements within the first four semesters of study.

## Entry Requirements

### Bachelors of Medical Sciences

North American Education Model: Applicants must have completed 12 years of primary and secondary school education with a minimum completion of 3 AP (advanced placement) courses. British Education Model: Applicants must have completed all educational requirements up to the General Certificate of Education (A-Level) level (Grades A-C) in English, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics.

All Other International Education Models: Applicants must meet their nation's equivalent of the above models (subject to individual review by the Admissions Committee). South East Asia: 10+2 with high scores in the IB, ISCE or CBSE examinations CARICOM countries: A minimum of Five CXC/CSEC (Grades I-II) with Biology, Math, Physics and Chemistry. Preferred: Three passes in 2-unit CAPE of which two must be in Biology and Chemistry.

#### 4 Year & 5 Year MD

Applicants to the MD program must have completed a minimum of 90 semester credits (135 quarter credits) of undergraduate studies, which include specific pre-medical requirements or their equivalents, from an accredited college or university, and have achieved a competitive Undergraduate GPA.



# Living Expenses

AUIS offers a limited number of rooms in our student housing facility in the safe and peaceful Bridgetown suburb of Kent Ridge, with direct school bus connection to campus. Furnished bedroom with a private bathroom in an apartment shared with one other student. Apartments are gendersegregated and available on a "first-come, first-served basis".

Below are costs for various accommodations. Pricing does not include utilities (gas, water, electricity, etc.)

- Modest apartment starts from 400 USD per month
- Standard apartment starts from 800 USD per month
- Luxury apartment: 1200 2000+ USD per month

# Scholarships

#### Merit Based

The AUIS Merit Based Scholarship rewards hard work with monetary rewards. A grade point average of 3.0 is required to apply for this scholarship. The tuition charge for MD 1-4 is \$6,600 per term, plus fees. College credits can be no more than two years old. Thereafter, recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA for every Basic Science term.

## Essay Scholarship

Research earns scholarship money. This scholarship is designed to reward future academic success rather than to penalize past performance. The criterion to apply for the Essay Scholarship is your Acceptance Letter

## Nurse to Doctor Scholarship

The AUIS Nurse to Doctor Scholarship rewards hard work and experience in the medical field with a unique scholarship opportunity. An RN or BSN with at least 1 year of work experience in nursing is eligible for the scholarship, which is valued at \$1,500 for the first term of Basic Sciences. Thereafter, recipients must maintain a 3.5 GPA for every Basic Science term to continue to receive this \$ 1,500 per semester tuition credit.
